Subject: Payment of DCRG to the absorbed DOT employees working in BSNL/MTNL w.e.f. 1.1.2016.

Respected sir,

This is regarding payment of DCRG to the absorbed employees working in BSNL & MTNL who were earlier working in the DOT prior to corporatisation w.e.f. 1.1.2016 as a result of the recommendations of the 7th Central Pay Commission.

Sir, the Department of Personnel & Trg has issued orders vide their OM NO 38/37/2016-P&PW(A)(i), Dated the 4th August 2016, regarding revision of Pensionary benefits for the Central Government Employees, basing on the recommendations of the 7th Central pay Commission which were accepted and implemented by the Government of India for all the Government employees. As per the OM cited above, the ceiling limit for payment of the DCRG is enhanced from the present Rs.10 Lakhs to Rs.20 Lakhs w.e.f. 1.1.2016. As per the OM the rates of ex-gratia lump sum payable to the dependents of the employees in case of their death while in service has also been revised.

Similar such dispensation is also required to be extended to the employees of DOT who are absorbed and working in the BSNL and MTNL and who are drawing Pension as per CCS Pension Rules. It is pertinent to state here that the DOT vide their letter no 40-31/2008-Pen(T), Dated 15.5.2009 have issued similar such orders consequent on implementation of the recommendations of the 6th CPC.

In view of the above, it is requested to kindly advise the Department of Telecom to issue necessary instructions to the BSNL/MTNL managements and the CCA units to implement the OM of Department of Personnel cited above with regards to enhanced payment of DCRG to the absorbed employees working in the BSNL & MTNL.
